“Contend for The Faith” Commitment

I invite you to read the following passage of scripture and pray about how God is asking you to step out in obedience and contend for the faith that Jude speaks of in Jude 3. “I felt compelled to write and urge you to contend for the faith that was once for all entrusted to God’s holy people.”

***Jude 20-23** - 20 But you, dear friends, by **building yourselves up** in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit, 21 keep yourselves in God’s love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life. 22 **Be merciful** to those who doubt; 23 save others by snatching them from the fire; to others show mercy, mixed with fear—hating even the clothing stained by corrupted flesh.*

In continued prayer and reflection, review and complete the following statements.

I commit to "contend for the faith" (Jude 3) in this season alongside others from ECC in two ways.

- As you pray about this step of commitment. Think about “building up our faith” as...

 - A disciplined commitment that stretches your faith.

I will specifically “show mercy to others”, (Share Christ) by...

- As you pray about this step of commitment. Think about “showing mercy to others” as...
 - A personal commitment that demonstrates your faith to others.
 - A sacrificial commitment that humbly loves others in faith.
 - A disciplined commitment that communicates the truth of God to others.
